Implementation facilitation, supports individuals, groups and organizations in their efforts to adopt and incorporate clinical innovations into routine practices. Implementing evidence-based practices and programs can be challenging, and facilitation, which can incorporate many other implementation strategies, such as audit and feedback, education and training, and stakeholder engagement, has proven successful in supporting implementation efforts. Facilitation has been widely used in many fields (e.g., management, education, social work, community development, mediation, as well as healthcare).
